Directions: * This liquid stains! Be careful when using *

Wet a gauze pad or a cotton ball with a generous amount of product. Apply to affected area and allow it to absorb. Cover with fresh gauze or old clothing that can be discolored. We recommended to use 2-3 times daily. It can also be added to a spray bottle for easy application.

- San Qi - Panax notoginseng (Chinese Ginseng)
- Gui Pi - Cortex cinnamomi (Cinnamon bark)
- E Zhu - Rhizoma curcumae (Turmeric Root)
- Bai Zhu - Atractylodes
- Hu Zhang - Reynoutria japonica (Japanese Knotweed)
- Bai Nui Dan - Inula cappa (Elecampagne)
- Qin Jian Ba - Flemingia philippinensis
- Huang Qin - Scutellaria root (Chinese skullcap)
- Zhang Nao - Camphor
- Bo He Nao - Mint
